Selection Process: Once the members of the Scholarship Committee have reviewed the applications, they will be submitted to an independent committee, not affiliated with the Cross Timbers A&M Club, for selection. The scholarship awards will be weighted on written application and if necessary, personal interview. The Scholarship Committee reserves the right to amend the selection process if necessary with the approval of the Club President.
