

MONTAGUE COUNTY RETIRED SCHOOL PERSONEL ASSOCIATION

SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS – included in 2017

1. The scholarship must be used during the first fall and spring semesters following the award of the scholarship.
2. The scholarship must be used for tuition, books or fees while attending a college or university located in the state of Texas. The scholarship committee must approve any other arrangement.
3. One half of the scholarship will be awarded during the fall semester and one half during the spring semester of the school year immediately following the awarding of the scholarship. A minimum of 12 semester hours each semester is required to receive the scholarship funds.
4. A grade point average of 2.5 or better must be achieved during the fall semester in order to receive the spring semester scholarship.
5. This scholarship must not be converted to cash in anyway. If a cash balance accrues to this account the balance must be returned to the Montague County Retired School Personnel Association.
6. The recipient must be pursuing a degree to prepare for the teaching profession.
