Redwine Honors Program Scholarship

Priority Deadline: January 15 (Late applications accepted.)

25+ Act or 1130+ SAT (excluding writing) or top 25% of graduating class or an IB diploma; \$2000 per semester for up to eight semesters

General Academic Merit Scholarship

Deadline: April 1

Students admitted to MSU are automatically considered for general merit scholarships through the MSU Admissions Office. Scholarships range from \$500 to \$2500 per academic year and are awarded based on SAT/ACT entrance exam scores. Scholarships will not be awarded after April 1st.

Deadline: April 1

Graduating senior of Burkburnett ISD who will attend MSU

Deadline: April 15 and Nov. 15

Preference given to financial services industry-related major

Deadline: May 1

Wichita, Archer, Clay or Wilbarger county high school graduate; Environmental Science or Biology majors

Priority Deadline: May 10

Graduate of Clay County high school

Deadline: May 10

Wichita or Archer county high school graduate, 23+ ACT or 1000+ SAT (excluding writing)

\$2,000 per year; renewable up to four years

Deadline: June 1

Male graduate of WFISD high schools, top 25% of graduating class; display exemplary character and citizenship during school career; financial need; selected by the principals (No application. MSU requests names of recipients from schools or names may be submitted to MSU at any time.)

Deadline: June 1

Permanent resident of Archer, Baylor, Clay, Jack, Wichita Wilbarger or Young county; declared major in College of Business Administration

Work Services Corporation Scholarship

Deadline: June 1

Disabled student passing all classes and registered with Office of Disability Support Services

W.P. and Ann Howle Scholarship

Deadline: June 1

Students who are engaged in or from families engaged in the building trade/construction industries

Red River Optimist Club Scholarship

Deadline: June 1 and November 1

Nursing or Education majors

Wichita Falls Club Capri Scholarship

Priority Deadline: June 15

Hispanic, beginning freshmen graduating from public or private high school in Wichita County

Deadline: June 30

Preference given to members of Wichita Falls Boys & Girls Club or any youth organization sponsored by the Optimist Club of Wichita Falls

Deadline: June 30

Permanent resident of Archer, Baylor, Clay, Jack, Montague, Wichita, Wilbarger or Young county

Deadline: June 30

Vietnam veteran, or spouse, child, or grandchild of Vietnam veteran

Deadline: July 1

Based on academic achievement, financial need and campus/community involvement; renewable

Priority Deadline: July 1

African-American graduates of high schools in Wichita, Archer, Clay and Wilbarger counties

Priority Deadline: July 1

Employee, spouse or employee dependent of the W.T. Waggoner Estate
