

Accelerated Reader Parent Access Information

Your child uses the Accelerated Reading program at school. The program offers two ways for parents to log in to see individual student progress. Parents are welcome to use either one or both of the parent information sites listed below to monitor student progress, look up AR books and point levels, and to view books that your child has tested on.

Renaissance Home Connect is a special feature of the AR program that allows parent access from any computer with an internet connection. Renaissance Home Connect gives students, parents, and teachers the ability to share information about student progress in Accelerated Reader. Parents must log in to each child individually to see the student information.

1. www.saintjoisd.net
2. Choose the library tab on the left side of the screen
3. Choose the AR login tab on the right side of the screen
4. Choose the I'm a parent option
5. Choose Request parent/guardian access?
6. Complete the requested information form

A parent access username and password will be emailed to you after the above steps are completed. Parents are able to view multiple student records with one password when viewing the information through this site.
