## RESOLUTION TO ORDER SCHOOL BOARD ELECTION

Montague County - Bowie Bible Baptist, Bowie Public Library, Nocona Community Center, Tales & Trails Museum, Ringgold Fire Hall, Saint Jo Civic Center, Valley View Baptist Church, Montague County Annex Community Room, Sunset City Hall, and Forestburg Community Center, and

Cooke County - First Baptist Church, Muenster.

The Early voting polling places shall be at:

Montague County – Montague County Courthouse Annex Election Room, Nocona Community Center, Bowie Bible Baptist, and the Saint Jo Civic Center. There will be two 12 hour days during Early Voting, October 17<sup>th</sup> and October 24<sup>th</sup>.

<u>Cooke County</u> – Cooke County Courthouse Annex Courtroom, 8 am – 6 pm.
